



How do I get involved in Basketball at KDBA?

How do I register to a team?

What are the fees?

All new players must pay a Basketball WA player license fee of \$41.75.

This license will need to be purchased annually to participate in any Basketball WA Competition or Association.

Club fees are set by each individual club and will therefore vary,

Game Day fees for 2023 are \$9 for each game in the fixture per person.

Fill ins

If a team is short players and needs a fill in player, they must notify the competitions office prior to the start of the game.

A fill in must be registered to the team.

Fill in players must be playing up a division or playing up an age group and be acting as the 5th or 6th member of that team to be permitted to fill-in.

Example 1 – A fill in player who plays in division 2 can only play up in division 1 or up an age group.



Example 2 – An U16's player can fill in for U18 team with no restriction on the division.

A player can fill in for a team a maximum of 3 times in the same age group if they are playing up a division.

Registration

A player can register to two teams ONLY if they are in different age groups.

A player cannot register with two teams in the same age group.

How do I action a forfeit?

Seniors – Please forfeit via the Teampay app.

Select your team in the Teampay app and select "give forfeit" this will notify the association, and the association will notify your team and the opposing team of the forfeit.

Please ensure push notifications are enabled.

What is Teampay?

Teampay is an application for senior teams downloadable from the Google Play or App Store designed to make paying game fees for game nights easier.

It has functions such as splitting the game fee, notifying organisations of forfeits and various others. Teampay is compulsory for all senior teams who participate in Senior Competitions at the KDBA.

When the Team Manager/Organiser is setting up Teampay they will need a code from the Kalamunda and Districts Basketball Association to view their personal team on the dashboard. You can have multiple Team Organisers and Managers.

Are there fines for forfeits?

Yes, there are fines for forfeits. The most common fines are:

Forfeit notice under 24 hours - \$110.00. Forfeit notice over 24 hours - \$40.00.

Full entailment of forfeit fines:

20.8	Playing whilst serving an ineligibility period through Rule 20.1 or Rule 20.4.	\$50.00 plus forfeit of each game played, plus an additional seven (7) days ineligibility period served consecutively for each offence.
